Read John 6:1-15

GENERAL BIBLE STUDY

1. After reading this passage, pause and ask God what He wants you to know from this story.
2. What verse or phrase in this passage is most significant to you?
3. What do you learn about Jesus in the passage that makes you want to know Him better?

PASSAGE REFLECTION

1. Verse 6 tells us that Jesus was testing Philip. What lesson do you think Jesus wanted Philip to learn? What truth do you believe God wants you to receive from this passage?
2. What do you think about Philip and Andrew's answers to Jesus' question? How do you think you would've answered?
3. After witnessing what Jesus had done, how would you feel if you were gathering the leftovers?
4. How does this story change or challenge your view of Jesus?
5. Jesus uses the food from a poor, young boy, not a wealthy person or merchant. Why is this significant?
6. Jesus thanked the Father for the provision. How do you include gratitude to God as a part of your daily life?
7. After Jesus multiplied the food, the disciples delivered it to the crowd. Jesus invites us into what He does, just as He did with the disciples. How have you been a part of Jesus' plans?
8. The crowd wanted to make Jesus king by force. They wanted Jesus to fit into their image of what the Messiah should be. How have you tried to make Jesus fit into your plans?
